In the past couple of centuries the harmony in the natural world has been disrupted in the name of developments and it is the need of the hour to review the impact of the raucous man has caused.

OBJECTIVES OF THE CAMP

The Camp aims at helping these Children and Youth go beyond their limitations and rediscover their strengths to find confidence and self esteem and contribute wholesomely to the development of their personality. During the camping days they learn to find the beauty and resources of nature, identify the localized flora and fauna, learn to bond with others and work in a team. The spirit of adventure instills in them a new purpose and meaning of life. According to their individual need and capacity they learn to camp craft, hike and jungle trek. Most importantly they have immense opportunities to learn about local inhabitants, their customs and cultures and eventually learn to be more inclusive and open in their approach and better equipped to face the challenges of life. Certificates of merit, badge and performance reports are awarded to each successful Camper.

CAMP LOCATION

Kharkhola Forest Village, under Samsing Range, Kalimpong Forest Division, Dist. Kalimpong, West Bengal Camp Site is situated 72 km from Siliguri.

This camp site offers unique lush green forest rich with medicinal plants, flora & fauna and ideal place for Nature Study / Adventure Camping. This area also offers beautiful villages with view of two mighty rivers. (See Map)



HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Any boy or girl with disability between 5 to 25 years of age can participate. The intending participant and escort must register their names submitting the duly filled application form along with one copy passport sized photograph and camp Registration Fee. During the camp days transport, accommodation, food, training cost & other incidental expenditure will be borne by HNAF.

OUTSTATION PARTICIPANTS

Participants will reach Siliguri/ NJP Station/ New Mal Junction on 18th Dec. by 8 am. HNAF will arrange necessary transport for the participants from Siliguri/ New Mal to the campsite. Team will return on 23rd Dec. 2023 by 3 pm. Kolkata participants can avail Kanchankanya Exp. from Sealdah to New Mal Jn. & vice-versa on 17th & 23rd Dec. respectively.

Special arrangement can be made for participants from outside Siliguri for overnight stay at Siliguri on 17.12.23 & 23.12.23 night at their own expenses on prior intimation.

EACH PARTICIPANT MUST BRING THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES

OTHER MATERIALS: Gamcha/Towel, Tooth Brush and Paste, Cold Cream, Pen with Refill, Small Note Book, Torch with Battery. Colour Pencil, Water Colour Set, Cotton Rope 2mtr.(8mm) & Art Paper (to be provided by HNAF).

UTENSILS: Enamel / Steel Lunch Plate or Messtin, Mug, Spoon, Water Bottle.

Note :Name and address should be affixed on luggage. Campers should not bring valuable articles or money .

BEDDING: Polysheet (2mts. long) for Ground Sheet or Sataranchi. Two Blankets or one Sleeping Bag, Coloured Bedsheet, Airpillow.

CLOTHING: One / Two pairs of Cotton Trouser / Churider (for girls), two Cotton Shirts, Under Garments, one Pullover and Half-Sleeve Sweater, Windproof Jackets or Windcheater, Sunhat (to be provided by HNAF), Balaclava or Muffler, Woolen Socks, Cotton / Nylon Socks, Outdoor Shoes i.e. Cades / Hunter / Jungle Boot or Sneaker, Sleeper (for indoor use).

OPTIONAL ARTICLES: Camera, Binocular, Musical Instruments can be brought at own risk. **MEDICAL ASSISTANCE:** Medical assistance will be readily available throughout the Camping days.

If any camper is taking regular medicine, he/she must bring adequate personal medicine and prescription of the doctor and inform the camp guide in-charge before joining camp.


haf ABOUT HNAF
